WHO WE ARE

Extinction Rebellion (XR) is a global, non-partisan, decentralised autonomous organization. Born in 2018 out of the acute need to bring forth the true sense of urgency around the climate crisis we use Non-Violent Direct-Action (NVDA) to persuade governments and courts to act justly on the Climate and Ecological Emergency. XR has three core demands that are incorporated and pursued by over 160,000 activists around the world.



OUR DEMANDS

TELL THE TRUTH

Governments must tell the truth by declaring a climate and ecological emergency, working with other institutions to communicate the urgency for change

ACT NOW

Governments must act now to halt biodiversity loss and reduce greenhouse gas emissions to net zero by 2025

GO BEYOND POLITICS

Governments must create and be led by the decisions of a Citizens' Assembly on climate and ecological justice

Creating a world that is fit for the next 7 generations to live in

2. WE SET OUR MISSION ON WHAT IS NECESSARY

Mobilising 3.5% of the population to achieve system change – such as “momentum-driven organising”

GLOBAL SUPPORT

XR Global Support (XR GS) exists to provide the infrastructure and tools for the world-wide movement. Through resources, direct funding, media communications, tech infrastructure, and trainings, global groups can access the help they need to enable self-directed action. In alignment with the decentralised character of our movement, Global Support's objective is not to be a global governance body but to offer support to XR groups based on their own local needs and strategies. Everything we do is shaped by our Principles and Values.

We are a movement of "ordinary" people. Anyone, anywhere, who adheres to the Principles and Values can act in the name of Extinction Rebellion.

FINANCIAL REPORT: 2025

Executive summary

In 2025, XR Global Support (GS) generated total revenues of **£221,521** and incurred total expenditures of **£228,751**. Crowd funding was **£122,770** and major donors **£98,752** which remained the primary funding sources. GS disbursed **£184,267** for Programme Costs and **£44,484** for Administrative Costs. The disbursement of grants was **£104,636** with **£42,357** for Africa and **£62,279** outside Africa. This large amount outside Africa was due to a major COP campaign in Latin America.

However, Q1, Q2 and Q4 ran a deficit as funds received per quarter didn't cover expenses. Donations from Crowd Funding and from XRUK and XRUS proved insufficient to cover costs. One major donation from XR Netherlands in Q3 was enough to cover expenses for that quarter.

In 2025 the grant payout Outside Africa was higher because Latin America launched a fundraising campaign to mobilize actions in multiple countries

to protest against the COP international climate conference held in Brazil not accomplishing what is needed given fossil fuel lobbyists' influence.

REVENUES 2025

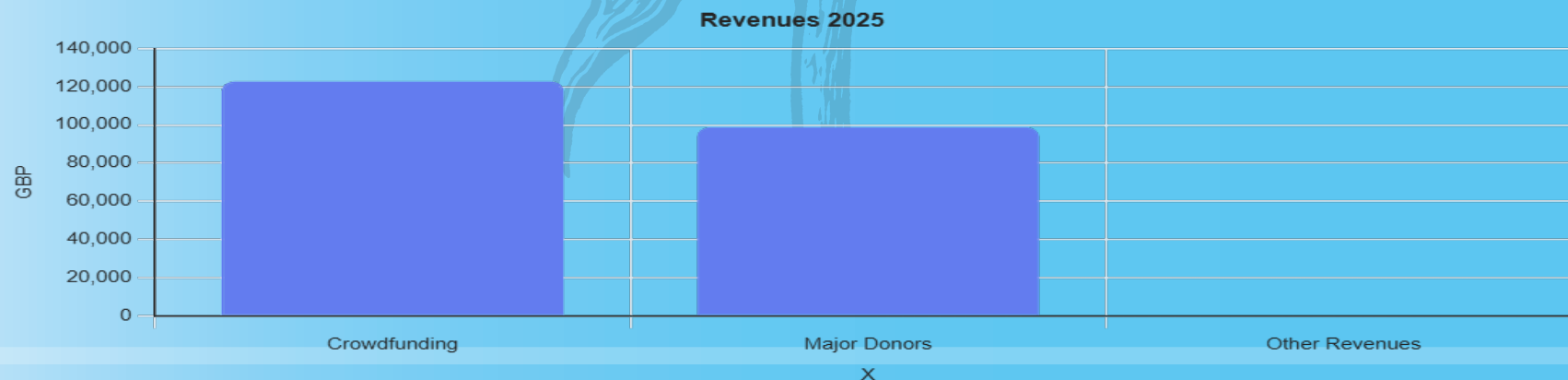
Total revenues were £221,521. Crowd funding contributed £122,770; major donors contributed £98,752. Revenues in 2025 increased by 7% from 2024 year-end balance. Crowd funding as a source of income formed 55% of revenues, 45% of the revenues was made-up by major donors.

Contributing factors including a fundraising campaign run during the period and donations from other climate activist organizations and climate support well-wishers.

Major Donors and Grants

As noted above, GS did receive grants throughout the year from 3 major donors, **XR Netherland, XRUK and XRUS**, in this category in 2025. We report our historic revenues for completeness.

These grants were mainly ring fenced to grant requests for actions by groups, regional liaison Volunteer Living Expenses payments and server expenses [Refer to Appendix B](#)



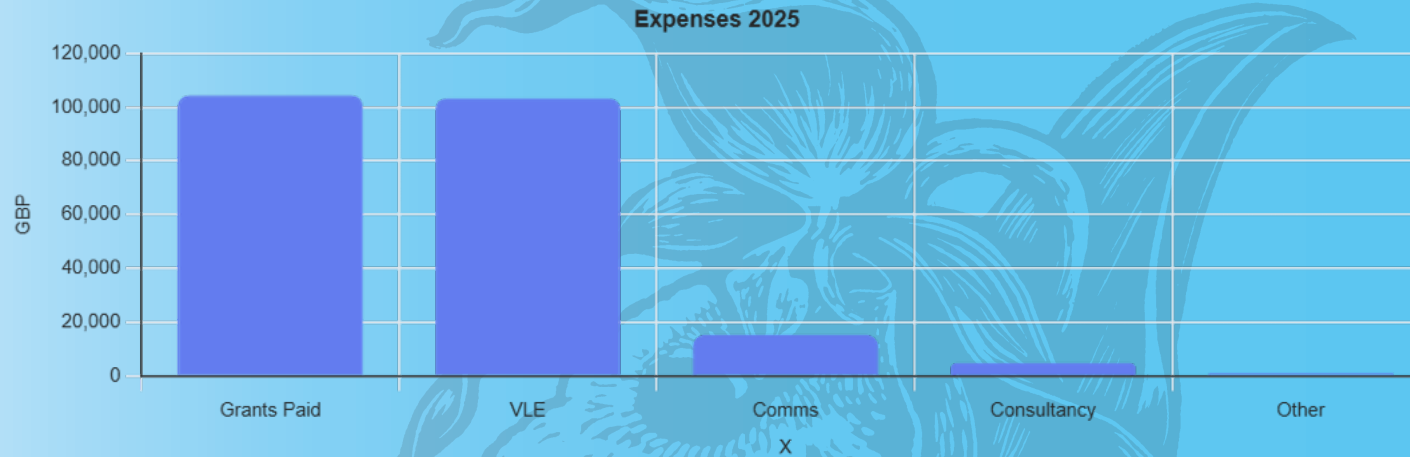
**PROTESTING PLANNED OIL BLOCK SALES

EXPENSES 2025

Total expenses were **£228,751**. The largest categories were Grants Paid (**£104,432**) and Volunteer Living Expenses (VLE) (**£103,245**), followed by

Communications (**£15,252**), Consultancy professional to C2025 for their services (**£4,779**), and Other (**£1,043**).

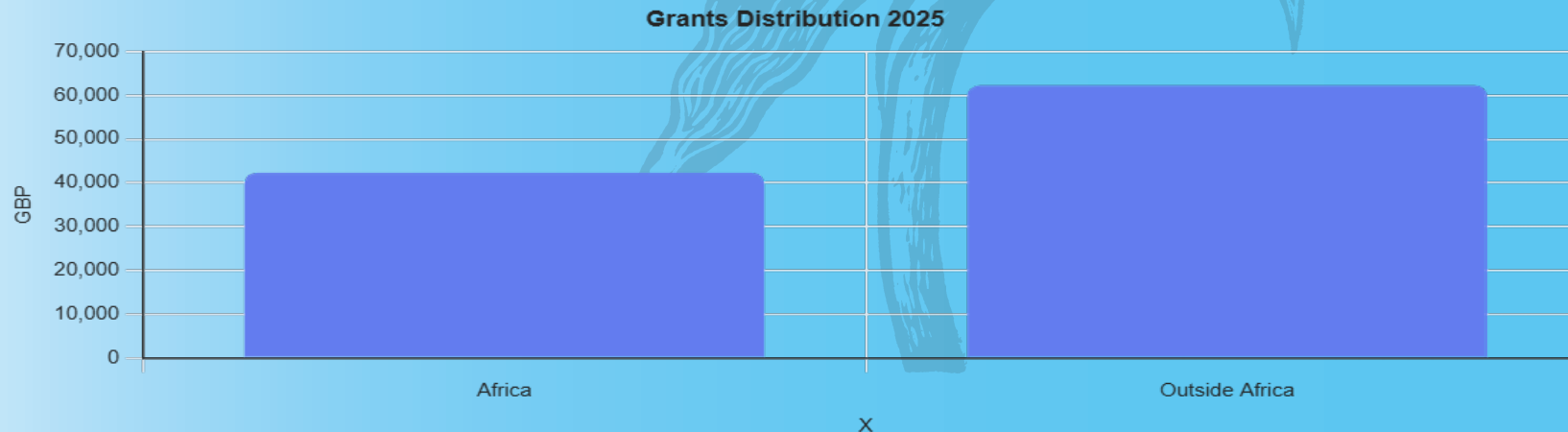


Grants Paid

GS disbursed £104,432 in 2025, with allocations of £42,357 to Africa and £62,279 to regions outside Africa. Grants outside Africa were higher as more actions were run in the last quarter by Latam.

These were high value grants. All disbursements followed GS's grant review framework.

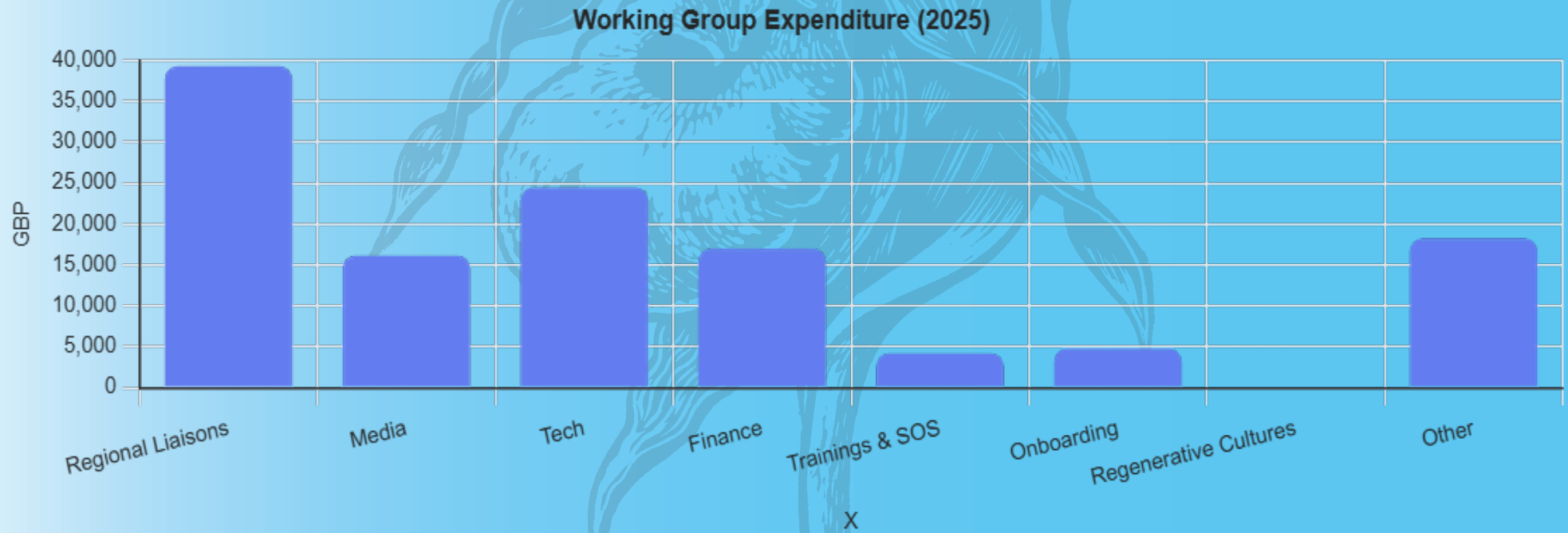
